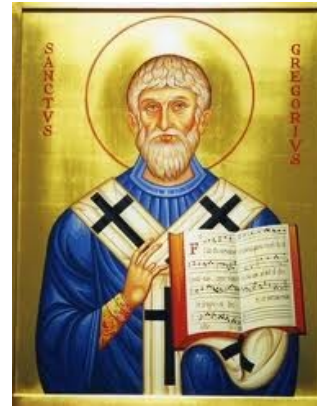

*Fr. Paul writes:-*
