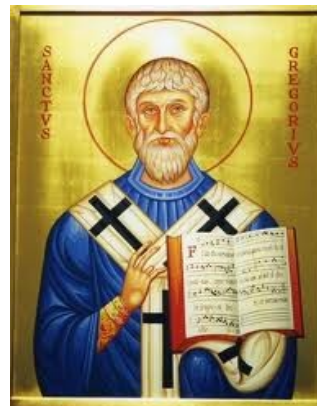

This weekend we are celebrating two unique events in the life of the church and in our own parish— The Ordination to the Priesthood of Deacon Mark Dunglinson along with five others at Westminster Cathedral and The First Mass of Fr. Mark Dunglinson in our own church.

Mark was first sent to us three and a half years ago to give us some help and support during Holy Week. In that brief time he made his mark as someone who loved engaging with people and who was willing to help out and serve wherever he was asked. (That meant in the kitchen, answering the doorbell and the phone as well as “official” roles in the Church!).

Over the past three years Mark has been given other placements in different places to widen and deepen his experience of ministry and parish life. During these Mark has often found time to come back to South Ruislip and keep contact with us. That bond brought him to ask if he might celebrate his First Mass here. What an honour for us all.
