**Fr. Paul writes:**

*In today's Gospel we listen into Jesus praying to His Father and His Spirit - the community of love we call the Trinity. There are two other instances like this in the life of Jesus, at His Baptism in the River Jordan and at his Transfiguration on the mountain. There the voice comes from heaven—here it is from the earth. Jesus' prayer comes after he has experienced rejection from his own townsfolk and is followed by a chapter full of conflict and a hint that there are people bent on getting rid of him.*

*In the midst of all these difficulties Jesus turns to His Father and proclaims his faith and trust in Him. Then he changes direction, as it were, and turns to us who are listening—"Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened and I will give you rest" And he describes himself as a Master and Teacher who is "meek and humble of heart and you will find rest for your souls" Finally he proclaims that "my yoke is easy and my burden light"*

*We may be here after a difficult week. We will certainly remember experiences of rejection and misunderstanding from others. We may have ourselves heavy burdens to carry in our lives. We will certainly know others whose burdens are crushing and destructive. Jesus' words and prayer today may help us and show us how to let our burdens and those we see in others, encourage us to trust above all in God's providence and love.*
