*Fr Paul writes:*

*What Jesus experiences in today's Gospel is something most of us are facing or have faced in our lives - rejection and failure. There are two lessons we can draw from the story. First, that there is a way of paralysing someone, of reducing them to powerlessness, simply by withdrawing confidence from them, imprisoning them in ready made categories. That is what the crowd did to Jesus. It is so easy let others feel discouraged by our judgements on those we think we know. In our estimation of them do we leave any room for hope?*

*We need also to remind ourselves that God calls each of us using frail and vulnerable people (just like us!). The guest, the neighbour, the sick person, the little child, the stranger, the one at my side - these can all be instruments of God's grace. What is called of us is to live expectantly in hope and to be ready to find God in unexpected places and unexpected people.*
