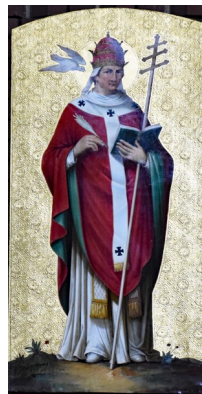

Fr. Mark writes:-

In this Sunday's gospel we hear of Jesus teaching in the synagogue in his home town of Nazareth. Although most of the assembly were astonished at Jesus' teaching, they just could not understand where this man got all of this wisdom, and how he was able to perform such miracles. After all, this was 'only' Mary and Joseph's son, and they simply could not accept him. Jesus' response may seem a little harsh but he is simply pointing out their lack of faith, and how this lack 'blocks' miracles from happening. The message is clear for us: we must never take the Lord Jesus for granted and become over familiar to the grace from the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. Familiarity can indeed breed contempt. Let us be more like those few people in Nazareth whom Jesus was able to cure.

Talking of miracles: thank you for your prayers, and a heartfelt thank you to all those who attended my ordination and first mass last weekend. It was wonderful to see so many of you there. I am particularly grateful for all the hard work which went on behind the scenes to make my mass of Thanksgiving so beautiful. I was extremely moved and delighted by how it went. The reception afterwards was lovely and all my friends commented on the warm welcome they received. Thank you for all the generous gifts. It simply will not be possible to thank you all individually, but I am truly grateful. May God bless your generosity.
