Fr. Paul writes:

In Luke's gospel, the mission of the seventy-two disciples (today's excerpt) has a two-fold meaning. On the one hand it indicates that the announcing of the kingdom of God was not confined to the twelve apostles; in the Acts of the Apostles we find other missionaries continuing the mission of the seventy-two. On the other hand for the Jews of Jesus' time the number itself represented the sum of the pagan nations, believed to be seventy two. It is not a chance happening then that Jesus, several times in his journey to Jerusalem (and to his passion, death and resurrection) announces the future salvation of the pagans.

The aim of this apostolic ministry does not consist in personal success for the preacher but in preparing people for their personal meeting with Jesus Christ. The missionary works for Christ, urges people to receive him and allows Christ to shine in him/her in all that he/she says and does. This is why prayer is so important in missionary activity. To pray is to call on that infinitely great "power that God has exercised for us believers" (Ephesians 1:19), it is to bore into the depths of humanity in order to make Christ spring forth.

Through our Baptism, we are ALL called to be missionaries. To be missionaries, we need to be PRAY-ERS!
