*Fr Paul writes:*

*When Jesus sends his apostles out it is no light-hearted affair. It required them to have deep faith and trust in him. It needed them to travel light and to depend on the kindness and hospitality of those to whom they were sent. Like him they were to proclaim the Kingdom of God, to call people to repentance and to bring healing to the sick. They were not to imagine 100% success - in fact like Jesus they would encounter hostility and rejection. But there is urgency in the task. That task is ours today!*

*“Proclaim 15” is an initiative by the Bishops of England and Wales to support and inspire ways of carrying out Jesus’ mission. Yesterday, (Saturday) there was a national event in Birmingham with 850 representatives from all over England and Wales. They were celebrating their Catholic Faith and seeking ways of how better to share it with others. From there hopefully there will be encouragement for the rest of us to get on with the job!*
