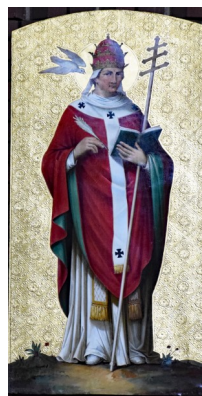

*Fr. Paul writes:-*

*The Gospel passage in today's Mass has Jesus sending his apostles out on their mission. It was to be a no light-hearted holiday affair. It demanded of them deep faith and trust. They are to go and do what Jesus does—preaching and teaching the Good News of the Kingdom of God present here on earth. Nothing had prepared these Galilean fishermen for such a mission. But what matters is not the brilliance of their intelligence, the eloquence of their words, or their family background. Getting rid of useless baggage and merely human assurances, they must let Christ speak through their mouths and act through their hands. The success of their mission is not guaranteed. Those to whom they speak may be unwelcoming or half-hearted or even hostile! That doesn't stop them - they have been seized by God, chosen by his Son and filled with his Spirit. There is an urgency about their mission.*

*Things haven't changed since the time of that first mission. Our world needs to hear that Good News today. We are called to be it's bearers. We may feel inadequate to the task, ill-equipped to proclaim the message and wary of living our Christian credentials outwardly. But it is the Lord who will speak through us, it is the Lord who will work in us if we just trust in Him. We are all charged with awakening our world, our society to the wonders of Jesus' Good News and the presence of His Kingdom among us.*
