Fr. Paul writes:

My priest friend in the States, Fr. Mike Tegeder, died on 9th July. May he rest in peace. He was 67 years old. My personal thanks to all of you, who joined many others in America, and held him in prayer over the past few months. He leaves behind his mother (93) two brothers and one sister. I am going to Minneapolis on Tuesday for his funeral on Wednesday (20th). The last minute nature of this plan has made it impossible for us to find a priest to cover Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday of next week. Sr. Joanna will lead a Communion Service on these days (at 10am).

Many schools have already broken up for the summer holidays. Ours has another two days to go. St Swithun Wells School has been saying Thank You to three members of the staff who are moving on. Mrs Helen Andrews has been Headteacher for the past eight years and in that time our school has being rated as "Outstanding" by Ofsted. Under her leadership it has gone from strength to strength and we wish Mrs Andrews every blessing in her new School which is only 10 minutes from home. (There were times when it took her an hour and a half to get to St Swithun's!) She will also be near to her two grandchildren. We are also saying "God Bless and goodbye " to Mr. Patrick Tidd, our Deputy Headteacher, who leaves to take up a similar post in a larger school. He came to SWW just before Mrs. Andrews. A third member of staff on the move is Mrs Caroline Courtney, a well known parishioner and Eucharistic Minister here at St. Gregory's. After a 4 year part time course she has qualified as a teacher and has been given an appointment at St. John Fisher, North Harrow.

We are very pleased to welcome in September, the new Headteacher, Mrs. Kristy Davis, who comes to us from St Mary's, North Kensington. Like her predecessor, she comes originally from South Wales.
