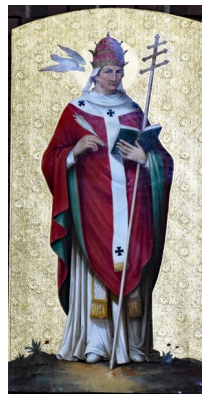

PENITENTIAL ACT OF POPE FRANCIS *PHOENIX PARK, DUBLIN*

We ask forgiveness for all cases of abuse, the abuse of power, the abuse of conscience, and sexual abuse on the part of representatives of the Church. In a special way, we ask forgiveness for all those abuses that took place in different kinds of institutions directed by men and women religious and other members of the Church. We also ask forgiveness for cases in which many minors were exploited for their labour.

We ask forgiveness for all those times when, as a Church, we did not offer to the survivors of any type of abuse compassion and the pursuit of justice and truth by concrete actions

We ask forgiveness for some members of the hierarchy, who took no responsibility for these painful situations and kept silent.

We ask forgiveness for those children who were taken away from their mothers and for all those times when so many single mothers who tried to find their children that had been taken away, or those children who tried to find their mothers were told that this was a mortal sin!

May the Lord preserve and increase this sense of shame and repentance, and grant us the strength to ensure that it never happens again and that justice is done. Amen.

Secondary School Year 7 and 6th Form Applications 2019

If any of your applications are for a Catholic school or a faith school you will need to get a reference from your parish. In the case of Catholic schools you will need a Certificate of Catholic Practice. This document needs to be signed by a Priest known to the child and his/her family and stating that the child is from a practising Catholic family. If you are not known to Fr. Paul and do not come regularly to mass at St. Gregory's it will not be possible to issue such a Certificate. Fr. Paul will also need to see a copy of the Baptismal Certificate. Times and dates when Fr. Paul will be available to sign the Certificates will be published the weekend of 8th/9th September.

Weddings

Couples wishing to marry here or in any Catholic Church need to give at least six months' notice of their intentions.
