CARDINAL JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

Preacher, Teacher, Prophet, Saint

(1808-1890)

Blessed John Henry Newman will be declared a SAINT at St. Peter's in Rome on Sunday 13th October. Over the next two months there will be several opportunities for us to come to know more about his life, his prayers, his hymns and his teaching.

Before his canonisation on Sunday 13th October there will be a NOVENA OF PRAYER over nine days - beginning on Friday 27th September and ending on Saturday 5th October. The Novena will take place after 10.00am Mass excepting on Saturdays when it will be after the 5.30pm Mass. The Novena will consist of some short thought or prayer of Blessed John Henry, an opportunity for all those who wish to make a petition to God privately and to conclude with an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be. There will also be a box for people to leave their petition(s) (as is done in Lourdes, Fatima). It will be good if as many as possible can commit themselves to coming to the novena. And for those who can't to pray it at home.

During the month of OCTOBER there will be 4 talks about our new Saint on Wednesdays 9th/16th/23rd/30th in our hall at 7.30pm along with our friends from St Mary's Church in The Fairway.

Parish Administrator North Harrow - St. John Fisher

Secondary School Year 7 and 6th Form Applications 2020

If any of your applications are for a Catholic school or a faith school you will need to get a reference from your parish. In the case of Catholic schools you will need a Certificate of Catholic Practice. This document needs to be signed by a Priest known to the child and his/her family and stating that the child is from a practising Catholic family. If you are not known to Fr. Paul and do not come regularly to mass at St. Gregory's it will not be possible to issue such a Certificate. Fr. Paul will also need to see a copy of the Baptismal Certificate. Times and dates when Fr. Paul will be available to sign the Certificates will be published shortly.

Weddings

Couples wishing to marry here or in any Catholic Church need to give at least six months' notice of their intentions.
