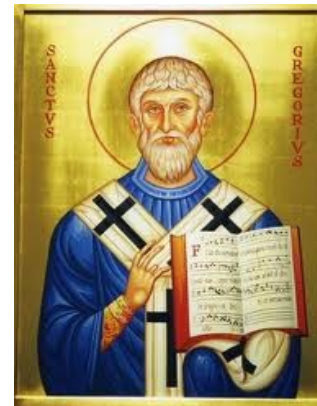

Today's Gospel
