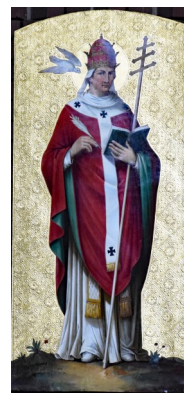

PARISH NOTICES**Secondary School Year 7 and 6th Form Applications 2020**

If you are applying to a Catholic or faith school you will need to get a reference from your parish. For Catholic schools you will need a Certificate of Catholic Practice to be signed by a Priest known to the child and his/her family and stating that the child is from a practising Catholic family. If you are not known to Fr. Paul and do not come regularly to mass at St. Gregory's it will not be possible to issue such a Certificate. Fr. Paul will be available to sign these Certificates on the following dates:-

Friday 18th October - 5pm to 7pm

Saturday 19th October - 2pm to 4pm

Monday 21st October - 5pm to 7pm

There are lists in the porch for you to write your details next to an available appointment time. One time slot per family. **Please also collect a secondary school/6th form transfer information sheet from Fr. Paul and return along with a copy of the child's baptismal certificate (if not baptised at St. Gregory's) at your allocated appointment time.** These dates are for secondary school applications and sixth forms only, primary school applications will be dealt with later in the year.
