Fr Paul writes:

A very happy Feast day as we celebrate St Gregory the Great, the Pa-tron Saint of our parish! We are also remembering particularly on Saturday evening (19th) the first anniversary of the death of Fr. Alan Ashton. There will be visitors at the Saturday evening Mass from the parishes where Fr. Alan served—New Southgate, Kenton, Royston, Wembley (Preston Road) and Fulham. Alan liked a party so I am hoping that our celebrations this weekend will combine the conviviality of parish life and prayer for Fr. Alan.

At this weekend we are also celebrating Home Mission Sunday and our bishops have issued a Letter concerning our parishes and the mission that lies ahead for all of us. Copies of the letter will be available to all after Mass. Every parish is being invited to set some targets regarding our interaction with the people around us and the building up of the Christian family.

I am proposing two modest initiatives. We will hear about the first next weekend—when a representative from the St Vincent de Paul Society will speak at all Masses inviting you to re-establish a group in our parish to have concern for and support people in need. The second concerns our neighbouring Church of England parish—St Mary's in The Fairway. I have been having conversations with Fr. Nicholas, their vicar, over the past few months. Out of them has come a proposal that during the year we might have two six-week programmes, one in the autumn and the other in Lent. One will take place here and the other at St. Mary's. Both will be a great opportunity for us to work and pray together. More details next week.
