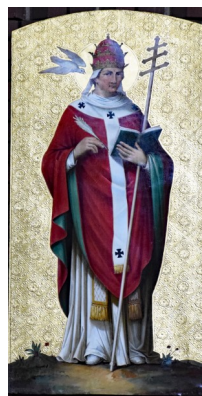

Fr. Paul writes:-

I have been very mindful of your kind wishes and offers of prayer for me as I have undergone further surgery on my elbow and am now on the path of recovering greater mobility and movement in that area. My surgeon predicts that it will take three months of physiotherapy and exercise to achieve the best possible results. So I ask you to keep up those prayers and to have patience in the meantime!

May I recommend a few events and activities over the next few weeks which could deepen our faith and help build up and strengthen our parish community. October is the Month of the Rosary and Pope Francis has appealed to the whole church that we all engage in this very traditional and popular prayer. There are two opportunities each week for us to pray the Rosary together. On Sundays at 4.30pm there will be October Devotions which will include the Rosary, some hymns to Our Lady and the Litany of Loreto. Each Sunday will concentrate on one particular set of mysteries. On Wednesday morning's after Mass (10am) there will be a simple recitation of the Rosary. Do come and join us!

During this month we are also having our four sessions on the Gospel of St. Luke. Each session stands on its own so feel free to come when you can. This Monday we are welcoming Rev Peter Anthony, a friend of Fr. Eric (St Mary's, The Fairway) to talk to us.

As you might recall, we currently have 8 initiatives in place; Home Visits, Care Home Visits, Hospital Visits, Refugee Detention Centre Visits, Bereavement Counselling, Foodbank, Prayer Events and Twinning.
