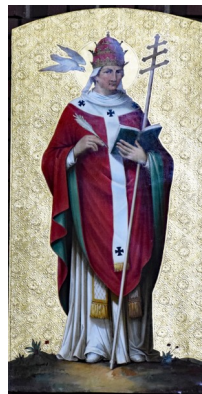

Fr George taught for many years at Cardinal Wiseman and Douay Martyrs and so will be well known to many in these parts. I am told that he also came to celebrate Mass here when the current parish priest was away. He was 86 years old and has been a priest for 62. May he rest in peace.*
