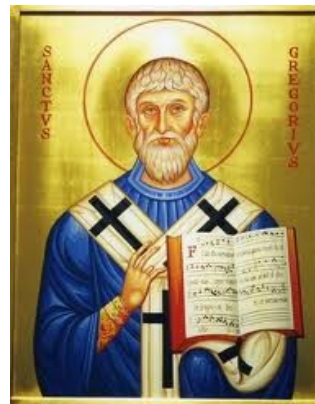

Fr. Paul writes:

The Bishops of England and Wales invite us to make today a day of prayer for peace and to reflect on the theme Pope Francis has chosen "Good Politics serves peace"

Today's Gospel gives us a most wonderful basis for reflection on our calling to work together for peace (and to get involved in the political process too, in order to seek that goal) We meet Jesus, his mother and his disciples at the Wedding Feast of Cana. He shares in our human joys—the joys of family, the joys of human love and the pledge of fidelity that unites one heart to another. But he also shares in our sorrows— Mary's cry "They have no wine"; the realisation that our own resources are run dry, our bonds of love prove fragile, our promises are all too easily betrayed.

Mary's advice "Do whatever he tells you" shows us that a new world is possible . We might be totally pre-occupied (or fed up!) with Brexit. But there are other issues clamouring for our attention and action. Peace is possible— but only if we dare to hope and dare to be caught up in the hour that has not come quite yet; only if we who recognise our thirst "They have no wine" will follow Mary's call and "Do whatever he tells you"

This is the largest detention centre in Europe and the need is great for volunteers who can accompany the detainees on what can be a lonely and stressful journey.
