Fr Paul writes:

Pope Francis in his words closing the recent Synod of Bishops in Rome had some interesting and direct words to say about the Church "This is the Church, who is not afraid to roll up her sleeves to pour oil and wine on people's wounds, who doesn't see humanity as a house of glass to judge or categorise people. This is the Church, One, Holy Catholic and Apostolic and composed of sinners, needful of God's mercy. This is the Church, the true bride of Christ, who seeks to be faithful to her spouse and to her doctrine. It is the Church who is not afraid to eat with prostitutes and tax collectors. The Church that has doors open to receive the needy, the penitent and not just those who believe they are perfect. The Church that is not ashamed of the fallen brother or sister and pretends not to see him/her but on the contrary feels involved and almost obliged to lift him/her up and encourage him/her to take up the journey again and accompany him/her towards a definitive encounter with her Spouse in the heavenly Jerusalem" Newspaper reports here suggested that the Synod was a failure - Pope Francis sees it as part of an essential process through dialogue towards finding concrete solutions to so many difficulties and innumerable challenges which families today must confront and to give answers to the many discouragements that surround and suffocate families (today). The debates continue over the next year when there will be another Synod in October 2015.

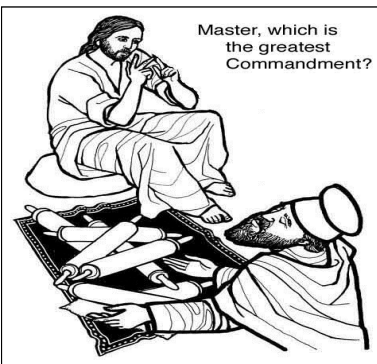
