*Fr. Paul writes:*

*On Monday 25 of us will be setting off at the crack of dawn to begin our Year of Mercy Pilgrimage to Poland. The choice of Poland is related to this Jubilee Year of Mercy initiated by Pope Francis last November because near Krakow (where we will be staying for four nights) is the Shrine of Divine Mercy. Devotion to Divine Mercy has come about in recent years because of the visions and writings of a young Polish nun, Faustina Kowalska who was declared a Saint by her fellow countryman now Pope Saint John Paul II. In the course of our pilgrimage we will also be honouring another two saints, Maximilian Kolbe and Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) both of whom perished in the concentration camp of Auschwitz which is near by. Finally we will visit the ancient and much-revered shrine of The Black Madonna (otherwise known as Our Lady of Czestachowa).*

*The whole parish will be remembered daily in our prayers.*
