

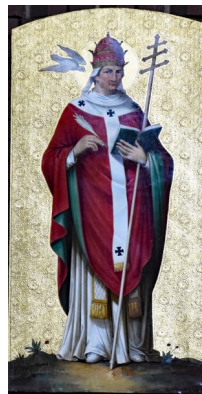

Fr Paul writes:

Every parish is required to have a Finance Committee which is responsible for the safety and management of all the funds of the parish and ensuring that these are kept in a diocesan account. It is also required to decide on the form in which the accounts shall be presented to the parish.

Recently, our parish (along with some others) was subject to an audit - and was found wanting (in the language of the financial world to be "Non Compliant") on a number of issues. In my role as your Parish Priest I have set up a new Finance Committee to tackle these issues. Part of its brief will be to keep you informed about our financial situation and to explain our commitments to the running not only of our parish but to the Diocese.

I am sure that for most parishioners all these things are a bit of a mystery! You see in the newsletter every week your kind and generous contributions of the Offertory collection and other Special Collections such as "The Sick and Retired Priests", "Cafod" etc. Some people even think that the total of the money is my wages!!

We are having a meeting of the new Committee this week and an important part of our work will be to keep all of you in the picture regarding the income we receive from you and the expenses we pay out.
