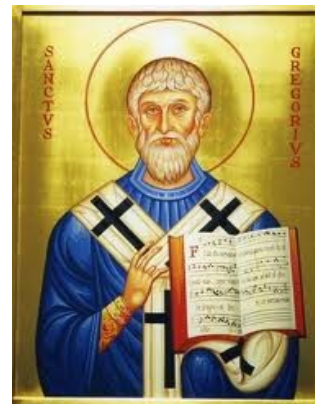

This Monday I will be setting off for North Wales to St Beuno's Spirituality Centre to make an 8-day individually guided Retreat.
