*Fr. Paul writes: The Gospel reading for today and the next two Sundays are very significant accounts which increase in intensity and lead us to the celebration of the Great (or Holy) Week. Today we hear the account of the Woman at the Well, next Sunday the Blind Beggar and on the following Sunday, the Raising of Lazarus from the dead. As we listen to them we must remind ourselves that they are not just nice stories from the past—they are about NOW and that Jesus waits to quench our thirst, to cure our blindness and to raise to life what is dead in us. Carry on with those Lenten resolutions and make sure that you avail yourself of an opportunity to go to Confession before Easter and to leave time to celebrate the great events of Holy Week.*

**HOLY WEEK (2)**

*The Great Three Days (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday & Holy Saturday) are really three parts of ONE celebration. This is demonstrated by the fact that there is no dismissal after Maundy Thursday or Good Friday and no opening penitential rite of Good Friday or Holy Saturday. Please do your best to be at all three ceremonies and so come to celebrate the real joy of Easter. Because there is a progression in the three days Mass on Maundy Thursday is a simple affair and the adornment of the Church and the Altar of Repose subdued. This year the Altar of Repose will be in the Hall.*
