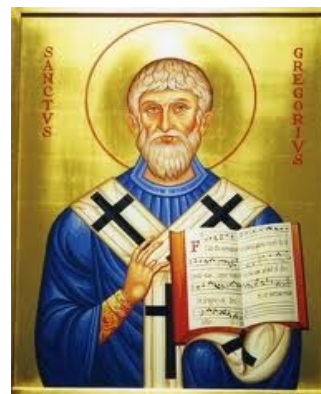

Fr Paul writes:

Today's beautiful readings at Mass give us much to think about and reflect on. The Gospel is from the beginning of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. The Beatitudes (as they are known by) are seen by some Biblical scholars as "Jesus' Charter" and the core of his teaching. They certainly reflect the sentiments continuously expressed by Pope Francis. The words of the prophet Zephaniah (1st Reading) look to a future where people will live the Beatitudes - that is NOW! St Paul's words (2nd Reading) remind us that we can only achieve this by relying on the help and grace of God. Are you and I willing to let ourselves become God's instruments and his spokespeople? Look at your own heart and mind and ask "What are my priorities? Do they fall in line with Jesus?"
