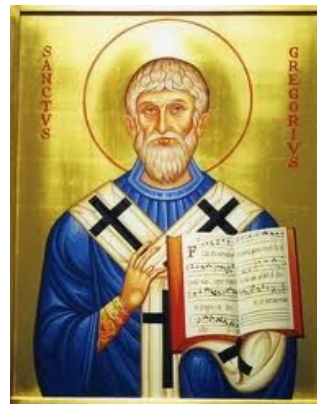

Here's a little preview of what's on offer both in St. Gregory's and there are also some shared events *with our neighbouring Church of England, St. Mary's in the Fairway.*

1. *Why not come to weekday Mass? (10.00am each day except Thursday).*
2. *Stations of the Cross (1pm Mondays & 7pm Fridays) *We are invited to St. Mary's on Fri 9th March and they will come to us on Fri 16th. At St. Gregory's various groups will lead the Friday stations.*
3. *A religious film will be presented each Wednesday apart from Ash Wednesday in St. Gregory's Hall at 3pm.**
4. *There will be a Lent court *on Thursdays at 7.30pm in St. Mary's Vicarage.*
