Fr Paul writes:

Allen Hall, our diocesan seminary where students train to become priests, has asked us to welcome Mark Dunglinson for the ceremonies of Holy Week and Easter. Mark will be with us this Sunday at the 10am Mass to say "Hello" and to see for himself what wonderful people you are! Do give him a warm welcome.

In a recent address Pope Francis said this: "The Sacraments are God's demonstration of closeness and tenderness towards humanity; they are the concrete way God created to move closer to us, to embrace us, without shame for our limits. Without doubt among the Sacraments, it is that of Reconciliation (or Confession) that best shows the merciful face of God. We must never forget that there is no sin that God cannot forgive. None! Only what is hidden from divine mercy cannot be forgiven, like those that hide themselves from the sun cannot be illuminated or warmed."

As we enter the second half of Lent I hope that everyone will think seriously of preparing for Easter (which is what Lent is all about) by availing themselves of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. There are opportunities here on Saturdays and in Holy Week after Mass. There are also two special celebrations on Tuesday 31st March at The Church of the Most Sacred Heart, Ruislip and the Church of The Immaculate Heart of Mary, Hayes. Both at 7.30pm.

There will be a number of priests available at both.
