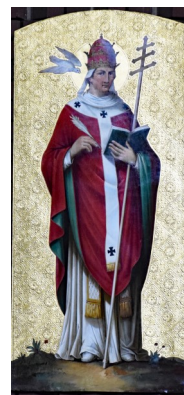

Fr. Paul writes:-

The month of May is traditionally a time for us to celebrate the first and greatest of all Christians, Mary the Mother of God. We hold in veneration a creature like all of us but one who is sinless through the power and mercy of God because of her role in God's plan to be the Mother of Our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Throughout history she has been honoured and celebrated by the Church for her faith in God, for her generosity in saying "Yes" to God's plan and as an example to all of us in recognising what God does for us in our lives. She has stirred the imagination of artists, composers and poets. She appeals to us as a mother who knows the ups and downs of human life. She is in a very real way— Our Mother.

*Among the many devotions to Mary two stand out—The Rosary and The Angelus. Next Friday, our School comes in Procession to the Church at 9.30am to crown her statue and to pray the Rosary.
