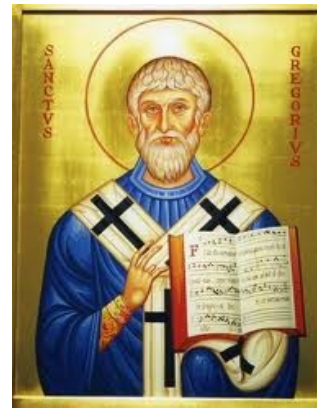

The celebrations of First Holy Communion and Confirmation in our parish are now over. Congratulations to all our candidates, their families and all who helped them prepare for their big day.

First communicants and their families are reminded that there will be a special Mass for the whole group on Sunday 18th June at 10.00am.

Celebrations continue in a wider sense in the diocese for we are in the season of Ordinations and we are lucky that two students who have served in our parish will be receiving Holy Orders over the next few months. Mark Dunglinson will be ordained Deacon on Saturday 10th June in Westminster Cathedral at 10.30am. All are welcome. Mark will be with us in two weeks (3rd/4th June) and on the day after he is ordained will exercise his new ministry here at 10.00am Mass on 11th June. Deacon Peter McLaren will be ordained Priest by his Archbishop, George Stack, on Saturday 29th July at 12noon in Cardiff Cathedral. Likewise all are welcome and I am making enquiries regarding a coach to get us there (more details next week).
