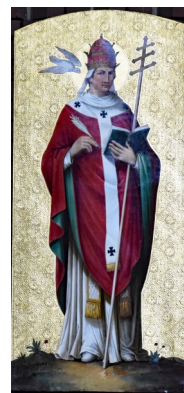

It is NOT a cemetery where traditionally places of burial are marked by gravestones and memorials. The families of those ashes are buried in our Garden are invited to have a plaque mentioning the name of their loved one erected on the wall. This is to be the normal and only way of making known to everyone those who are buried in the garden. In order to maintain the area as a garden where all may come and pray I am asking all families who have their loved one's ashes buried here to remove ALL articles that have been placed by them by 30th June 2019 so as to allow the appearance of a well-tended garden to be more conducive to prayer, remembrance and peace.*

*I am aware that this request may upset some. If you are upset please come and see me. I think it is only fair that our lovely Garden should always be a place of beauty and peace for all. Its newly painted railings provide an opportunity for us to maintain a dignified and ordered resting place for those who have gone before us. May they rest in peace.*
