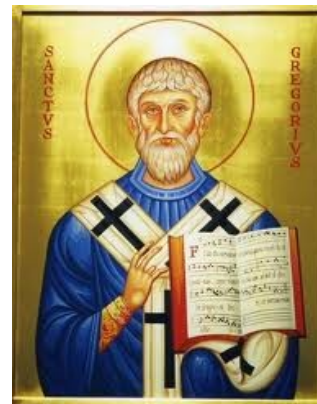

Fr. Paul writes:-

The awful event in Manchester last Monday evening with its consequences of the deaths of innocent and mainly young people, the horrific and continuing injuries of many others and the varied reactions of people in the media and through social networks has touched our hearts, and, I am sure, has left us with many questions. As Christians, we are firstly to show loving and practical support where we can to those whose lives have been devastated particularly the bereaved and families whose members have been injured. Part of that support will also be in prayer. Secondly, in our social response and communications and discussions among each other it is important that our thoughts and contributions do not resort to the level that is a root cause of the situation - extremism. That and any reaction which promotes hatred and division will only produce more of the same. The basic Christian message is LOVE and wherever there is a situation or a context where individuals respect each other and in their diversity seek to work for the common good then good must and will prevail. We need to promote friendship, harmony and trust in our society. We should resist blaming others, for promoting peace begins with each of one of us making a conscious effort to be good citizens and loving Christians.
