Fr Paul writes:

The Eucharist is a sacrament which should fill us with wonder. To penetrate so great a mystery we must begin with what we see, in order to reach that in which we believe and so partake of what is there.

WHAT WE SEE. *Human realities (bread and wine) taken and given by Jesus so that we may eat and drink*

WHAT WE BELIEVE. *The Supper that Jesus shared with his disciples prefigured the sacrifice of his life he was going to make the next day. Under the sign of bread and wine Jesus gives us his life so that we may share in his. At the altar where we share His Body and Blood he is substantially present.*

WHAT IT IS. *What we receive we become - the Body of Christ*
“When the priest says “The Body of Christ” to each communicant he is saying “Receive what you are “ (St Augustine).

Today, at the 10am Mass, we welcome all the children who made their First Holy Communion on three Saturdays in May. We offer our congratulations to them and our thanks to all who helped them prepare for this special step in becoming true friends of Jesus - their parents, their teachers and their catechists.
