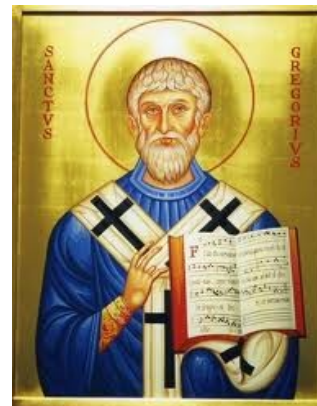

Fr. Paul writes:- Deacon Mark Dunlinson will be with us this weekend for his last visit before his Ordination to the Priesthood in Westminster Cathedral on Saturday 30th June at 10.30am. Everyone is very welcome to the Ordination Mass where he will be ordained along with seven others. The ceremony will last the best part of two hours!

Many of you will remember Fr. Alan Ashton who came with me to our parish four years ago and who died just a year later. Alan specified in his will that his chalice should be given to a newly ordained priest. So Mark will be the recipient! I will leave the chalice out on display this weekend so that you can have a closer look at it. Alongside it will be a silver bowl which the parish has bought to give to Mark. It has been inscribed with his name.

Mark has finished his academic studies at Allen Hall, the seminary where he has studied over the last four years. We have been blessed to have him with us at various times over that period. Now he will be soon going on retreat in preparation for his ordination. Please remember him in your prayers.

Fr. Mark(!) will be returning here to St. Gregory's to celebrate his First Mass on Sunday 1st July at 5.00pm. We are very honoured that he has chosen South Ruislip for this unique celebration. In coming weeks there will be further details about the preparations for it.
