Fr Paul writes:

One of the many assurances we have in celebrating our faith is that we are not alone either in our struggles and difficulties or in our successes and triumphs. This assurance is demonstrated each week when we gather together for Mass. Here it is that we acknowledge that all of us stand in need before God and that all of us together offer prayer and (where we can) loving support for each other. That prayer and loving support is not restricted to our gathering at St. Gregory's, South Ruislip—we join with the whole Church worldwide. That unity is signified in a special way today when we celebrate the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome. St. John's is Pope Francis' cathedral (many people think it is St. Peter's!) and is known as the Mother Church of the world to which all other Catholic Churches are linked.

Unity and solidarity is also being celebrated in the secular world as we observe Remembrance Sunday. A special focus this year is the centenary of the outbreak of World War One. It is a time to remember that our freedom today has come at a cost of many millions of lives in that and subsequent wars. At Mass we pray for all who have died for others and commit ourselves to work wherever we can to establish true justice and peace in the world.
