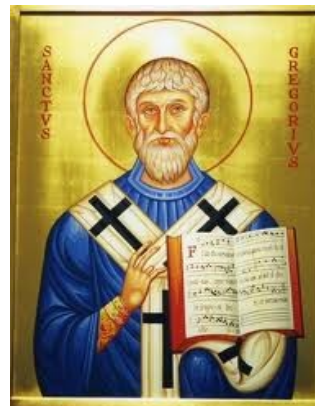

*Fr. Paul writes:-*

*When I was first ordained (45 years ago!) it was customary for the Bishop to send a Pastoral Letter to all the parishes to be read at all Masses on Trinity Sunday (today's feast). We priests assumed that it was an act of kindness by the Bishop to spare us the task of having to put together a sermon on the most unique (and complicated) of the Church's teachings! It took the Church over three hundred years to compile and involved much argument and discussion. At times when the arguments got so heated they resulted in some bishops tearing at each others beards!*

*In his teaching Jesus refers often to His Father and The Holy Spirit and implies that They are all equal. When the early church proclaimed that Jesus was both truly God and truly Man it was faced with the question that if Father, Son and Spirit are equal are there Three Gods? Today's feast declares that They are Three Persons but One God. It's a teaching that is difficult for us to imagine but at the centre of it all it proclaims that Our God is a community of love and that the gift of faith that we have received draws us into that community so that we share in their life. It is the unique Christian teaching and one which we avert to every time we make the Sign of the Cross!*
