Pentecost, the Feast of the Coming of The Holy Spirit, is popularly known as The Birthday of The Church. There is much to celebrate here in St. Gregory's. On that day, too, one of our seminarians, Mark Dunglinson, will be receiving Candidacy in Allen Hall, the seminary. Candidacy means that the Church sees someone as a suitable candidate for the Sacrament of Holy Orders. And we mustn't forget our Deacon Daniel who will be ordained Priest on Saturday 2nd July in his home parish of Scunthorpe. If you would like to be there today is your last chance to put your name on the coach list. The Birthday of the Church is a day for all of us—to thank God for the gift of Faith, our Baptism, and all the gifts of God that we have received individually.
