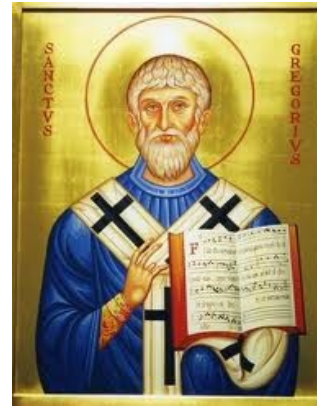

Fr. Paul writes:-

The event of Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit transformed the lives of the apostles and spurred them into action! Today is a moment for all of us to recall that we too have received the gift of the Holy Spirit at our Baptism and our Confirmation and are called to be (as Pope Francis frequently reminds us) "missionary disciples".

Part of our role as missionary disciples is to support and encourage those who are wanting to know more about our faith and who might themselves be thinking of joining us. Every year we try to have a "Journey in Faith" programme particularly for those interested in becoming Catholics but also for baptised Catholics who want to catch up on their faith (they may not have made their First Communion or may not have been confirmed).

Blessed Frederic Ozanam, the founder of the SVP in 1833, was clearly moved by the workings of the Holy Spirit within him. They asked him what use his Faith was, if he was not willing to put it into real action. He reacted immediately (a typical 20 year old!) and that very night went out and bought some firewood for a family in poverty living nearby. And the rest is History!
