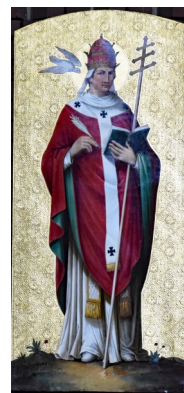

*The Feast of Pentecost is traditionally known as the Birthday of the Church for it is from that event that the apostles filled with the Holy Spirit went out to tell the world of their day of the Good News (Gospel) of their Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Ever since that Gospel has been announced and preached throughout the world.*

*This week's moving celebrations in Portsmouth and Normandy marking the 75th Anniversary of D-Day and the eventual ending of World War II, have reminded us all of the importance of recalling the actions of thousands of people (many of whom died in the process) of putting ourselves before others and enabling those who came after them to live in peace and freedom.*
