The ***Growing in Faith*** campaign here at St Gregory the Great continues to receive support from many parish families. To date, we have raised over **£130,000** from **39** gifts. The average pledge in our parish is £3,300 over 5 years, £12.70 a week.

We are now approaching the final stage of ***Growing in Faith***. Our aim has been to receive an informed decision from everyone in the parish and to date we have done well in reaching the majority of parishioners. We plan to complete our efforts next weekend. The Bill to legalise "assisted dying" - meaning assisted suicide - will be debated in the House of Lords on 18th July 2014. There will be a free vote because it is not government legislation. If passed, this Bill would place vulnerable people at serious risk. Especially if you have direct experience of caring for a dying person, either as a family member or as a health or social care professional, please write before 18th July to a Peer to tell them your views.
