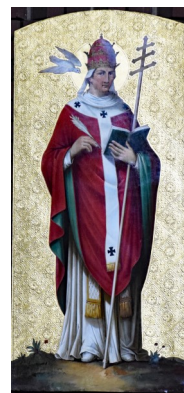

### *Fr. Paul writes:*

*Today we remember and celebrate the lives of Saints Peter and Paul, the two pillars on which Christ built his Church, the two very different characters Jesus chose to spread the Good News of the Gospel. It's true to say that Peter wasn't always the "rock" Jesus named him. Before Jesus died he was impulsive, given to cutting off people's ears and making protestations of loyalty he didn't keep but Jesus knew that this simple fisherman had in him the necessary capacity for authority to become the Church's solid foundation.*

*In Paul we have a very different character to Peter: a dynamic individual who did everything with the utmost enthusiasm. If he was persecuting Christians, he did it with a vengeance; if he was acting as Christ's apostle, he did it fearlessly. Peter was a man trained to catch fish; Paul was an intellectual, a trained rabbi, steeped in the minutiae of the Jewish Law.*

*Through meeting with Jesus both men had their lives transformed. Jesus harnessed their individual characteristics and strengths to build his Church. Their commitment to Christ in spreading the Gospel led them to exile in Rome where both were martyred reputedly on the same day.*
